Proposed Activities for 2006:

- Review and submit for approval the NWSA Player Classification Handbook
- Review/Develop paperwork for use in player classification process
- Review and approve classification paperwork submitted by players / classifiers
- Review and approve process for accepting and verifying classifications given to players from other athletic organizations, and develop priority of those classifications
- Develop protest process, paperwork, and final classification determination process for players and members at NWST
- Review and approve credentials for classifiers to be used at NWST, provide oversight of activities of classifiers at NWST and organizers of NWST.

NWSA Bylaws Language:

- The following are the general committees established by the Association: Hall of Fame, Rules, and Classifications.
 - (1) The members of the above committees shall be appointed by the President of the Association in consultation with the Commissioner and approved by the Executive Committee. The President shall designate one member of each committee as chairperson.
 - (2) Each chairperson is authorized to recommend to the Executive Committee that a member be replaced if such member is not discharging his/her duties properly. The Executive Committee shall have authority to remove by majority vote such member and appoint a replacement.
- The Rules Committee shall invite and review proposed modifications, deletions, or additions to the rules of the National Wheelchair Softball Association.
 - (1) It shall have the sole authority to implement any such modification, deletions, or additions subject to the approval of the Executive Committee and the membership of the National Wheelchair Softball Association at its annual meeting.
 - (2) All proposals for changes, in playing rules shall be presented in writing to the rules committee thirty days prior to the annual NWST.
 - (3) Rule modification, deletions, or additions brought before the membership at the annual meeting and approved shall go into effect on the first of January following the annual meeting.
